The VON Grey-Bruce Hospice Volunteer Visiting Program provides volunteer visits to clients who are facing life-threatening illnesses and/or those who are bereaved. The program serves the communities of Grey and Bruce counties, and surrounding rural areas, except for the Bruce Peninsula, which is served by Bruce Peninsula Hospice.

There is no fee for any services and visits are provided in the home, hospitals in Grey-Bruce, long-term care homes and retirement homes.
